Measurable Objective 1:

A total of 37 Third, Fourth, Fifth, Sixth, Seventh and Eighth grade Economically Disadvantaged students will demonstrate student proficiency (pass rate) on SBAC and MAP Testing in Mathematics by 06/05/2020 as measured by 50% of FRL students will show growth on MAP or improve 1 level on SBAC proficiency.

Strategy 1:

Ready & I-Ready curriculum & RTI - Carlin Combined School will receive curriculum for Ready Math and I-Ready intervention for students. Curriculum Associates provides in depth teacher training 3 times during the year. This will be the Math curriculum grades K-8 and an intervention for secondary students.

Kickboard - Online behavioral program Kickboard will be introduced to staff and students. SCEL and PBIS components are interwoven to improve school culture, track attendance and behavior in real time, and highlight positive behaviors in the school.
